

Peer Group Learning (PGL)

PGL is one of the activities endorsed by the RACGP as a CPD Accredited activity (**40 points**) It is, for many GPs, a great way to complete the college requirements for 2 CPD accredited activities during the current triennium, 2020 - 2022. A PGL is also a great way to get to know your colleagues and to learn from each other.

How to get started

Membership of PGL

Invite at least 2 GP colleagues plus or minus any other health professionals to form your PGL with a maximum of 12 per group. Arrange and hold a planning meeting at a time to suit the group. Appoint a GP facilitator, discuss the learning aims, outcomes and topics, and choose meeting times and set dates – and off you go!

Meetings

Arrange your meetings as it suits your group - with a minimum of 4 hours clinical learning plus your planning and review meetings. Meetings are recommended to be at least 1 hour in duration.

Completion

An evaluation and application form should then be completed online by your GP facilitator. NB You can participate in as many cycles as you like but each application needs to be completed within a calendar year.
